WESTERN JET stalked along the two path, lodged a bid to compete with a furlong to go and then finished gamely. BAD BOY BUBBY never far back, three path on the turn, split foes late and closed well. RADICAL STORM broke well, set the pace along the two path, was hooked and weakened. I'LL MAKE IT UP tracked along the three path and weakened. REMORSE never far back along the rail and weakened. SUNDAY DREAMER four path on the turn and then finished wide. LIL TREE three path on the turn, wide stretch, was outrun. NORMAN'S GOOD BOY two path on the turn, was outrun.
