EXLEY tracked, took command on the turn, drifted in late bothering SAY HALO SANDY and then bested that one. SAY HALO SANDY gained along the rail on the turn, lodged a bid inside, was bothered by the winner, checked late and then still held the place. POLICY WONK broke well, set the pace, was hooked, chased and finished well. SEA YA SISTA was unhurried, angled out in the lane and made a late bid. TITLETOWN TIGER was unhurried, responded late and made a mild bid. PETEY BEDOUIN lagged back, angled out and then failed to menace. COLE'S GOT SOUL was well placed to the lane and weakened. SMOOTH KAHLUA four path on the turn and tired. KID GUSTO was done early. A stewards inquiry was posted concerning the stretch. Also a claim of foul was lodged by the rider of SAY HALO SANDY against the winner for interference in deep stretch, resulted in the disqualification of EXLEY from first to second.
