BAD DECISION gained five wide on the turn, collared the leaders at the top of the lane, battled and got the job done. PEGASUS SMILE broke on top, set the pace while pressed to the line and just missed. CAT PHONE never far back, saved ground, eased out and finished well. PANAMANIAN PLAYBOY forced the issue along the two path, between into the lane and weakened. FAIRWAY TOM was well placed along the four path on the turn and weakened. ADMIRAL BIRD four path on the turn, lodged a bid outside and hung. FEARLESS BUZZ never far back along the three path and weakened. ONE LITTLE SECRET two path on the corner, was not a factor. SECRETS ONLY five wide into the lane and then finished wide. THE ARTIST checked hard from between foes early and then could not keep up. RULE SEVENTY SIX showed little.
