MIA'S HALO was well placed while three abreast after a half mile, chased on the final bend, moved to take the lead with a furlong to go and then drove clear late for the win. EXCELLENT MINUTE set the pace while pressed, dropped back into the lane, chased, responded to the whip and finished well to clearly best the rest. MADAMELOUISE was in hand early along the four path up the backstretch, swung out into the lane and then finished with interest. BEBOP BLUES five wide on the first turn, lacked a rally. SEA OF LOVE between foes early, angled to the rail after a half mile and then lacked a rally. NONRECOURSE checked along the rail at the three-eighth pole and then was outrun. REASON TO BE ASTAR lacked the late needed response. FIFTY DEGREES stalked the leader while between foes, moved to take command into the lane, was hooked with a furlong to go and then gave way.
