CAT A BIT checked at the start and then saved ground while never in it. EGAN GIRLS R WILD gained some along the two path on the last turn and flattened out. ROYAL BRIDGE was unhurried, three path on the last turn and tired. OUR HELEN WHEELS lagged back along the rail and tired. I'M THE MIZZ was well placed saving ground throughout and tired. SHA SHEAR EGO tracked along the three path and then was completely done on the last turn.
