BOB THE POOL MAN tracked along the two path on the turn, responded to steady pressure and was along in time. SPYGLASS broke well, set the pace along the rail making every step a winning one except the last one. CONFLICTED was well placed along the three path, loomed a threat and hung. SOUTHERN ROCKET gained along the rail into the lane and flattened out. MORNING HERALD saved ground to no avail. LOVIN THE BLUES lagged back along the rail and tired.
