PAPA FRITA vied for the lead along the three path into the lane, battled in the drive and under the whip outran AUDIES CHAMP to the line. AUDIES CHAMP was well placed, tracked the leaders along the four path into the lane, responded and finished with good energy. KING'S FEZ never far back along the rail, angled out midway on the bend and rallied. KIP'S BOY vied for the lead along the two path on the corner, battled in the lane and weakened late. TUXEDO AFFAIR forced the issue inside, dropped back on the turn, angled out in the lane, gained some and then lacked room late and checked. ROLLOFTHETUNDRA broke sluggishly, two path into the lane and then lacked a rally. COURAGEOUS GENERAL three path on the turn and weakened. MAGGIE'S PRINCE gained some along the two path on the turn and flattened out. DANGEROUS MONARCH five wide on the turn, was not a factor. DAZZLING DEREK saved ground and tired. ARDGUN showed little.
