BARCO broke on top, tracked, challenged along the three path on the turn, battled to the line and proved best. INGER MANAGEMENT contested the lead off the rail, battled to the line and just missed. SEA YA SISTA gained along the three path on the turn and finished with interest. PAPA FRITA lagged back along the four path and then made a mild bid. CHARING CROSS forced the issue early along the rail, tracked inside and tired. REMORSE two path on the turn and weakened. CASTLE HARBOUR an early factor inside and tired. LEAP DAY away last, saved ground and tired.
