LONGING FOR MALIBU seven wide leaving the first turn, stalked along the four path up the backstretch, moved to challenge from between foes in midstretch, battled and under the whip edged clear. KING'S FEZ was well placed five wide on the last turn, challenged three across in midstretch to no avail but finished clearly best of the rest. WINITBACK sprinted clear early, showed the way off the rail and then weakened when challenged. A HAPPY LIFE taken back at the start, trailed and then was going well late. BEHRACUDA was well placed along the three path up the backstretch and weakened. PRO LOVE was well placed early, five wide on the final turn and tired. FORT MONTGOMERY slow to load in the gate, bobbed at the start, tracked early and tired.
