EXACT AGAIN broke well, vied for the lead from between, dueled on the last turn, put GREAT BEAR away and edged clear. GREAT BEAR was well placed along the rail, challenged inside midway on the last turn, battled to no avail but bested the rest. CRAFTY NOBLE was unhurried, saved ground and finished with interest. TRICKY BREAK was well placed along the three path on the turns and weakened. THE BUTLER DID IT vied for the lead three across after a half mile, dropped back along the four path on the last turn and tired. STAY HIGH STANLEY three path on the turns, was outrun. NUGGET OF WISDOM four wide on the first turn, three path into the lane and tired.
