Footnotes

GNARLY FARLEY assumed command, set the pace along the three path, drifted in at the three-sixteenths pole bothering WISE GUY KELLY, responded when asked and under the whip proved clearly best. WISE GUY KELLY well placed, tracked along the three path on the turn, angled in some into the lane, was bothered by the winner, checked, angled out for the drive and finished well to best the rest. TOP CAT TOO was well placed five wide early, six wide on the turn and weakened. VOLATILE STORM lagged back along the four path and then failed to take part. STRIKE JET was unhurried while five wide early, entered the lane seven wide and tired. DEE BOB an early factor while five wide, continued wide on the bend and tired. ORIENT SONG saved ground and tired. A stewards inquiry was posted concerning the winner in upper stretch. Also a claim of foul was lodged by the jockey of WISE GUY KELLY against the winner for interference at the three-sixteenths pole, resulted in the disqualification of GNARLY FARLEY from first to second.
