### Footnotes

LIVING RIGHT saved ground, gained along the rail on the last turn, entered the lane three wide, battled and proved best. SNAP CALL vied for the lead three across, dueled on the last turn, battled the winner along the rail to line and just missed. COOL OPERATOR vied for the lead from between, dueled off the rail on the last turn and then was done leaving the eighth pole. GOOGLY lagged back, three path on the last turn and weakened. GAP CLOSER vied for the lead along the rail and gave way. EXCESS BOOKS vied for the lead three across early and then was done along the three path on the final turn. ALLEN'S AFFAIR slow to load, stumbled at the start and then trailed while along the rail.
