SURFING IAN vied for the lead along the two path nearest the rail, kicked clear some in between calls, was hooked and weakened. WINGNUT never far back, three path on the turn, lodged a bid and hung. YOU WILLGO BROKE lagged back, three path on the turn and then lacked a rally. IS IT TUESDAY YET was well placed off the rail, loomed a threat inside and then flattened out. REGAL ENCOUNTER taken back at the start, rated along the two path and then never fired when asked. LAKE BUTLER vied for the lead three across and gave way. FAST APPROACH vied for the lead between and gave way.
