SEA YA SISTA ducked in, checked at the start, forced the issue four across early, dueled on the bend, responded and drove clear. FIFTY SENSE never far back, three path on the turn, angled out and finished with good energy. MAX CAM checked at the start, lagged back, two path on the turn, eased out and rallied. TIME FOR TRUTH two path on the turn, eased out and finished with interest. I CAN'T DANCE vied for the lead from between, dueled on the bend, battled with the winner in the lane and weakened. CASH ME OUT squeezed at the start, three path on the turn and then lacked a rally. SERIOUS ALERT four path on the turn and then finished wide. KWIK BULLET four path on the turn and then finished wide. HEADSTREAM vied for the lead along the rail and tired. KEEN IMPACT saved ground and tired. BLUE RIDGE GUY two path on the turn and was done early.
