WISE GUY KELLY was unhurried, gained along the rail on the last turn, eased out some, challenged and just missed. DAKOTA ROADHOUSE vied for the lead, shook loose some on the last turn, battled and faltered late. CRESCENT'S MON was unhurried, three path on the last turn, angled wide and closed well. MAGICAL DEVOTION lagged back, four path on the last turn, angled wide and found his best stride late. HE AINT EASY broke sluggishly, saved ground and made a mild along the rail. JARACAT vied for the lead and gave way. AOJA unhurried, three path on the corners and tired. SEVEN FIRSTS vied for the lead, four wide on the last turn and tired.
