Footnotes

CARLOW was unhurried along the three path, between foes midway on the turn, eased out in upper stretch, responded, rallied, spilt foes leaving the eighth pole, battled and proved best. SPEED BAG in hand early, four path on the turn, angled out in the lane, launched a bid to reach the leaders while five across the track with a furlong to go, battled with the winner and then finished gamely. CHAMPAGNE ENDING vied for the lead while three abreast, battled between in midstretch and weakened late. A ROSE FOR CHRIS lagged far back along the three path on the turn, angled out in the lane and then found her best stride late. SWEET SWEET MOLLY vied for the lead from between to midstretch and weakened. ONE O'CLOCK was unhurried along the rail, three path on the turn and then lacked a response. BOMBAY DREAMS vied for the lead off the rail to midstretch and faded. LINE MEMORY three path, was outrun. DANCIN ON BROADWAY an early factor along the rail and tired.
