SWEETNORTHERNSAINT broke on top, set the pace along the three path up the backstretch, responded when challenged leaving the backstretch and then widened under the whip proving clearly the best. TOMMASI was well placed off the rail, chased in the lane to no avail but finished with good energy. TIGER SPEECH tracked along the four path, challenged some leaving the backstretch, lodged a bid and finished with interest. HIDDEN EXPENSE was well placed up the backstretch, three path on the last turn and weakened. SENIOR checked midway on the first turn, gained five wide up the backstretch, four path on the last turn and weakened. C T CHIMES broke sluggishly, five wide on both turns and tired. MR. WINDJAMMER lagged back, was outrun.
