ROYAL GAME sprinted to a clear lead quickly, increased his margin while never being challenged, then drew off in the stretch under mild urging. LORD JET well placed and outside, improved his position four wide through the turn, then held the place while unable to gain on the winner. LOVIN THE BLUES allowed to settle, moved up on the two path through the turn, came three wide to bid and had a mild gain in the lane to get up for the show. COCOBOLO mid pack, move up inside through the turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch and ran evenly. BLACK PEN chased the pace and steadily lost ground. PERSONAL SPENDER allowed to settle, looped four wide through the turn and had no stretch rally. EARLY RESPONSE was no factor. TOMMY KARAKORUM reared at the start and was a brief factor.
