WHOWHATHOW sprinted to a clear lead quickly, increased while never being challenged, then drew off in the lane under steady pressure. DOUBLE CLAP allowed to settle, moved up inside through the turn, came through inside of rivals into the stretch and closed well for the place, while no threat to the winner. THANK'S FORTHE SON stalked the pace on the outside, lost ground throughout and held the show safe. GEE'S MONEY BOY had a wide trip and drifted out through the lane. CRACK EN TOO tracked the pace on the inside and faded in the drive. CHIEF FIRE WATER was no factor. POLITICALLY STEEL well placed and outside, looped four wide through the turn, bid on that path into the stretch and had no rally.
