**Footnotes**

GURDARSH set the pace along the rail, widened some on the last turn and then narrowly outran FONTODI to the wire. FONTODI gained along the rail on the last turn, eased out, gained and finished with good energy. FINAL STRIDE was well placed along the three path on the turns and finished with interest. SECRET DUKE in tight leaving the seven-eighths pole, checked hard, angled out to the four path entering the backstretch, three path on the last turn and weakened. PEAKED PERFORMANCE was well placed along the two path on the turn, dropped back into the lane and was distanced. MILLSTREET broke slow, saved ground on the turns, dropped back and was distanced. Claims of foul were lodged by the rider of SECRET DUKE against FINAL STRIDE and FONTODI for alleged interference leaving the seven-eighths pole, was not allowed.
