STORM FALCON in hand early, gained when asked along the three path on the last turn, took the lead in gear and drew off. PRINCE CODY tracked, dueled after a half mile, shook clear on the last turn and then was no match. TAPPED OUT BRUNO checked into the first turn, saved ground up the backstretch, continued inside in the lane and hung. PERFECT VELOCITY lagged back, three path on the last turn, angled out and hung. ARDGUN two path on the last turn and then lacked a rally. GARGANTUA saved ground on the final turn and tired. BEACH HARBER MAN vied for the lead after a half mile and tired. CHIEFTAINS WARRIOR checked at the start and then was outrun. COURAGEOUS GENERAL saved ground, was done early.
