GOOD AND GRATEFUL broke well, set the pace off the rail, was hooked in midstretch and then was no match. RATHSKELLER gained along the rail on the turn, lodged a bid outside and finished with interest. IRUSAN was unhurried six wide, five wide on the turn and then failed to take part. WINNING GOLD was unhurried off the rail on the turn and then failed to threaten. ERICA'S STAR was well placed along the four path on the turn and weakened. MOMLIKESMEBEST four path on the turn, was not a threat. ROARING BYE broke slow, lagged back along the rail, was outrun. I COMMIT MYSELF broke slow, lagged back while six wide, was outrun.
