KING'S LASSIE was allowed to settle, rallied five wide on the far turn, collared the leaders in midstretch, swerved in under the whip forcing FORTUNATE SWING to steady and drove clear at the end. FORTUNATE SWING steadily advanced four wide, steadied in mid stretch when the winner swerved in and then held on for the place. COMET BLUE was unhurried early, angled out in the lane and finished well. DARSELA chased and then weakened. LAITEE LEGS was slow early, swung wide and made a mild bid. OATKA LITTLE GIRL flattened out. ITS A JET chased and gave way. BEDFORD'S COMET was no threat. MISS GINALIE was hustled along inside, set the pace and faded. OFF TRACK FIRSTCAT tired. FIVE STAR AFFAIR flashed speed and was through after a half. A claim of foul by the rider of the second place horse against the winner for interference in deep stretch was not allowed.
