MARSH DAWG was well placed along the three path, angled out some, collared the leaders in gear and then drew off to be a ridden out winner. BONGO BOY lagged back along the four path, angled wide in the lane and rallied. WINGNUT was well placed along the four path, lodged a bid outside and finished with interest. SAY HALO SANDY six wide up the backstretch, five wide on the turn, continued wide and hung. FIRST REACTION was well placed along the three path, battled in the lane and weakened. ALABAMA'S JUMPIN lagged back along the four path and then lacked a rally. NIGHT IN TUNISA was well placed along the rail early and tired. BRASSY EVENT set the pace, was hooked, battled in the lane and gave way. FIDDLE FOR A BUCK was done early.
