CANWEWIN ducked out at the start, gained to challenge four across briefly at the top of the lane and then chased while besting the rest. CHAPEL CHIEF vied for the lead from between into the lane and weakened. ELEGANT JETSETTER jostled repeatedly just after the start, vied for the lead, between three deep into the lane and faded. DERBY NATION was well placed early, three path on the turn and weakened. HAROLDS WARRIOR two path on the turn and tired. N B RAVENS three path on the turn and tired. SMOOTH AND COOL saved ground, was outrun.
