SARATOGA SNOWPUFF bumped hard with FAIRYTALE ROMANCE at the start, set the pace off the rail and then widened in the lane to be a ridden out winner. DOLCELINA saved ground, checked nearing the seven-eighth pole, gained ground while five wide on the last turn, launched a bid in the lane and was along for the place. BURN DIXIE BURN was well placed, tracked the winner along three path, chased in the lane and then missed the place. FAIRYTALE ROMANCE bumped hard at the start, was well placed along the four path, lodged a bid in the lane and hung. HELLO JUDY in tight nearing the seven-eighth pole, lagged back off the rail and then failed to menace. SURGEON was well placed along the rail to the lane and tired. COO COLD BIRD six wide on the first turn and then was done early. JEZEBELLA saved ground, was done early. Claims of foul were lodged by the riders of DOLCELINA and HELLO JUDY against the winner for interference nearing the seven-eighth pole, resulted in no change in the order of finish.
