POCKET COWBOYS broke on top, set the pace off the rail, responded when challenged from both sides in midstretch and under the whip edged clear. SLEVIN was well placed off the rail, lodged a bid inside, challenged some to no avail but finished well. UNCLE T SEVEN unhurried, gained some along the three path on the last turn, angled wide and finished with interest. LEGAL CONSENT was well placed, gained along the four path on the final turn, chased, bid outside and hung in the crucial stages. LONGING FOR MALIBU was unhurried off the rail on the last turn and then failed to fire. MOMSBOY tracked along the three path and weakened.
