Footnotes

BEYYA set the pace off the rail, shook clear through the second turn, then dueled with ST PETE BEACH while drifting out through the lane, brushing that one and held under brisk handling. ST. PETE BEACH allowed to settle, moved up into the second turn, gained a striking position three wide through the turn, then dueled with the winner, being brushed and missed. DAVID'S FLAME allowed to settle, moved up between rivals into the second turn, looped three wide through the turn, was bumped by a tiring rival, then closed and evened out the final furlong. MIRTHFUL FLIRT mid pack, moved up four wide through the second turn, fanned widest into the stretch and weakened in the drive. POTNIA'S SONG vied for the early lead inside and faded after a half. DOUBLE PRIME tracked the pace just off the rail, drifted out into the stretch, bumping a rival and tired. BANDIT LADY steadied into the first turn, was no factor.
