WINNA WINNA was unhurried, two path on the last turn and then found her best too late. KNOWHENTHOLDDEM was unhurried, saved ground on the last turn, checked at the quarter pole and then failed to take part. Y. N. V. ME lagged back, three path on the last turn, was never in it. HAVANA GIRL gained some along the two path on the last turn and flattened out. S S TRAVERSE was outrun. SANDY CASTLE tracked for a half mile, two path on the last turn and tired. VALUABLE FRIEND four path on the turns, was done early. EYE CAN ROAR saved ground and tired. .
