FIRST FACE was well placed along the rail, slipped inside to take command and drew off. B AND B set the pace off the rail, chased to no avail while clearly no match. SHES TUFF AS NAILS was unhurried, gained along the three path on the last turn and finished well. JABEZ was well placed, appeared to have something left into the lane and weakened. SIMPLY STUNNING tracked, two path on the last turn and weakened. LOUDER THAN SOUND was unhurried, four wide on the last turn and weakened. MISS APOLLONIA saved ground while rated and tired.
