MASTER TEACHER was well placed, tracked along the four path, collared the leader, battled and under the whip got the nod. HEIRLOOM THIEF was well placed, gained five wide on the turn, challenged for the lead, battled and just missed. DIAMOND ROCK was unhurried off the rail, entered the lane four wide and finished with interest. RUNDOWN ROCKY was well placed while six wide, drifted towards the rail in the drive and hung. DISCO DOC lagged back, six wide on the turn and then finished wide. MARCY AVENUE six wide into the lane and then lacked a rally. PERSONAL SPENDER set the pace, was hooked and weakened. INDIGENOUS RULER tracked along the rail and tired. FREDDO JOEL three path on the turn and tired. ARDGUN was outrun. QUALITEX off the rail on the turn, was done early.
