MR MAGENTA vied for the lead three across, dueled into the lane, responded leaving the eighth pole and drove clear. PASSTHEPASTA PLESA was unhurried early, four path on the turn, entered the lane five wide and finished with good energy. LATE NIGHT HOOKUP vied for the lead off the rail, battled the winner in the lane and weakened. BARCO was well placed along the three path into the lane and weakened. IS IT TUESDAY YET saved ground, was not a factor. CHECK THE CITES vied for the lead from between leaving the backstretch and gave way. PERFECT DRIVE four wide leaving the backstretch and then saved ground into the lane.
