WARMHEARTED SANDY was well placed along the two path, eased out into the lane and drew clear while under the whip. STARBUCKETS never far back along the four path, asked into the lane, gained and finished well. HOOK IT UP vied for the lead four across early, dueled on the bend along the two path and weakened in the final eighth. STONERIDGE forced the issue early, two path on the turn and then improved her position. ECOACH was well placed along the three path into the lane, appeared in tight in midstretch, checked and weakened. ANNA MAE JONES vied for the lead along the rail and gave way. NIKKI'S EYES saved ground and tired. DEAR MARYLOU saved ground, was outrun. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of STARBUCKETS against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch, was quickly dismissed.
