CHEROKEE TRICK vied for the lead early, took command into the lane and then widened while whipped to the wire. GEORGIANA was unhurried off the rail, eased out and then closed well. CARMEN CAMACHO vied for the lead early, tracked in the lane and weakened. DEEWANEE was well placed along the three path and weakened. WEEFC was unhurried six wide on the turn and then lacked a rally. THATSURFINALANSWER was unhurried along the three path and weakened. B LONG TO MIO five wide on the turn and weakened. MAILGRAM lagged back off the rail, was not a factor. LOGANS REGAL CHARM forced the issue early, four path on the turn and tired.
