Footnotes

PERFECT GRATITUDE void of speed, moved up three wide through the second turn, fanned widest into the stretch, closed fast when clear and got up in the final strides. PRINCE HAPNICK well placed and outside, bid three wide into the stretch, dueled with DENALI BIRDSTONE to the final furlong, edged ahead of that one and was outfinished. SOCIO D'ORO mid pack, moved up on the two path through the second turn, came three wide to bid and lacked the needed late kick. LIFE OF A TIGER mid pack, looped three wide through the second turn, gaining a striking position, came four wide to bid into the stretch and weakened in the drive. GREAT BEAR improved his position. DENALI BIRDSTONE set the early pace off the rail, dueled through the lane with PRINCE HAPNICK and faded the final furlong. PLAYIN'INMYWHISKEY rated back in the early going, angled out to a stalking position, then had no rally. DOUBLE WHAM was no factor.
