### Footnotes

NEW YORK STYLE broke on top, set the pace off rail and then widened under the whip. AGGRESSION was unhurried, gained along the four path on the last turn, chased to no avail but finished best of the rest. SMART TOMCAT was well placed, three path on the last turn and weakened. WISEMAN JACK was unhurried, four path on the last turn and then lacked a rally. TAX EDITOR well placed along the rail on the first turn, five wide into the lane and weakened. PERSONAL SPENDER three path on the turns stalking the winner and weakened. OUR TRUCKING BARON four wide trip, was outrun. WISEMAN'S COWBOY checked at the start, saved ground on the turns and tired. FORT MONTGOMERY saved ground on the corners and then was done early.
