BOLD DIXIE was well placed along the two path, entered the lane three wide, took dead aim on the pacesetter, gained, challenged in gear and under the whip proved best. LILA LOUANN contested the lead along the rail, kicked loose in the lane, was hooked by winner, battled some to no avail but bested the rest. AMETHYST ROSE four path leaving the backstretch, two path into the lane, lodged a bid inside and hung. SLIPPERY BUTTER vied for the lead along the two path, chased in the lane and weakened. SMOKIN RACER two path leaving the backstretch, angled to the rail into the lane, in tight a furlong out, checked, angled out for room and made a mild bid. CUTE JAMMIES was unhurried, four path leaving the backstretch, angled wide for the drive and then failed to rally. CATHY ALL THE WAY broke sluggishly, lagged back saving ground and then failed to take part. TRI TO BEA EARLY close up early, three path on the turn and tired.
