Footnotes

COME ON OVER broke on top, set the pace in hand while removed from the rail, continued off the rail on the final turn, responded leaving the eighth pole and then was ridden out. SMALL TOWN five wide on the first turn, angled to the rail on the last turn, commenced a rally to have a chance, chased in the lane to no avail but finished clearly best of the rest. VLAST broke slow, lagged back saving ground on the turns, continued inside in the lane and was along for a share. FORTUNATE RUN was well placed saving ground, angled to the three path on the last turn while to the inside of rivals, appeared to be in a striking position and then weakened. TISNOW JULIE reared at the start, unhurried, entered the last bend five wide, took the four path into the straight, angled widest of all in the lane and then failed to gain. BULLNOSE BRICK never far back while six wide heading up the backstretch, five wide entering the last turn and then weakened. LOOPY DE LOOP forced the issue some early, tracked along the three path on the last turn and then weakened in the stretch. ELSAROARIN was well placed along the two path on the first turn, entered the final one four wide and tired.
