RUNLIKEACHAMPION contested the lead along the three path into the first turn, dueled up the backstretch, responded when asked in the lane and edged clear late while being ridden out. AOJA two path on the first turn, gained along the same path on the last turn, challenged some a furlong out and then was no match late. CALL TIGER was unhurried along the rail, gained some on the last turn, checked hard while lacking room at the top of the lane, stumbled, recovered, asked and rallied. PERRY LANE lagged back, two path on the turns, angled out, lodged a bid and then checked late. SARATOGA WARRIOR was well placed along the rail, angled out to the four path leaving the backstretch, took the three path on the last turn, moved to compete a furlong out and then could not sustain the bid. YOU'RE READY NOW was well placed, gained five wide on the last turn and flattened out. WANA PLAY contested the lead along the rail, battled the winner into the lane and faded.
