FACE IN THE MIRROR was well placed, gained along the four path into the lane, responded and got the job done. RUN WARRIOR RUN was unhurried, gained four wide on the last turn, entered the lane five wide, took charge and then just missed. BEDROCK BLUES never far back, two path on the last turn, lacked room in midstretch, altered to the outside and finished well. TWO CATS was well placed, challenged three deep between foes into the lane, chased and finished well. SILENT TRICK was unhurried, five wide on the last turn, angled out and made a late bid. KING KONG KINGDOMS lagged back, saved ground and then failed to fire. WESTERN DEED was unhurried, gained some along the three path on the last turn and weakened. RIVER MOUNTAIN RD was outrun. PERRY LANE vied for the lead and gave way. NEW YORK STYLE vied for the lead along the rail and gave way.
