LIFE OF THE CITY saved ground, appeared in tight into the turn, checked, angled out in the lane and made a late bid. BAY PARK BOY stalked the winner along the three path and weakened. BACKSTAGE PASS was well placed saving ground and weakened. BROOKLYN RED five wide up the backstretch, four path on the turn and tired. THAT'S FOR SURE four wide up the backstretch, three on the corner and tired.
