Y. broke well, vied for the lead off the rail, kicked clear some in the lane and then finished gamely. WHO'S LIVIN BETTOR three path on the turn, lodged a bid and was along for a share. FEARLESS BUZZ vied for the lead along the three path, chased in the lane and weakened. I CAN'T DANCE saved ground and weakened. REGAL ENCOUNTER five wide on the turn and weakened. MAX CAM lagged far back along the rail, was not a factor. ATHLEAGUE ROS three path on the turn and tired.
