WINLOC'S SUNSHINE was unhurried along the three path, gained ground into the lane, responded to pressure and rallied to be along in time. CARR QUEEN was well placed along the rail, lodged a bid inside, battled for the lead in midstretch, gained the advantage and then finished gamely to just miss. OUT OF SORT'S was well placed along the four path, angled out for the drive, lodged a bid and hung. ZACHS WORLD checked at the half mile pole avoiding the loose horse, six wide leaving the backstretch and then continued wide in the lane. HALO HALO HALO set the pace off the rail, was hooked in midstretch, battled some and tired. NEW YORK GOLD lagged back along the rail and then failed to menace. SEA OF HOPE tracked the leader along the three path to the lane and weakened. ANGIES STORM CREEK stumbled badly at the start unseating the jockey. A stewards inquiry was posted concerning the start, resulted in no change in the order of finish.
