ED'S MUSIC gained along the three path outside foes on the turn, angled in bothering OLD CITY into the lane, took the rail, collared the leader from the inside and drove clear. LORI CORLEONE broke sluggishly, saved ground, lacked room at the three-eighths pole, checked, angled out in the lane and rallied. WILDCAT'S ELEMENT was well placed along the rail, took the lead in midstretch and weakened. DEB'S PRETTY LADY was unhurried along the two path, angled out and made a late bid. OLD CITY gained along the rail on the turn, checked into the lane when the winner drifted in and then weakened. YVONNE'S DELIGHT stalked along the four path on the turn, five wide into the lane and weakened. T. Y. MIRACLE sprinted clear, drifted out at the top of the lane and tired. READING GLASSES was well placed early and tired. PYLORTES appeared to take a bad step early and then pulled up. Claims of foul were lodged by the riders of OLD CITY and LORI CORLEONE against the winner for interference at the three-eighths pole and quarter pole, was not allowed.
