WINGNUT broke well, stalked while five wide, challenged the leaders while three across into the lane, took charge and under pressure got the job done. SLIWA was well placed, gained along the three path, chased in the lane and finished well. SAY HALO SANDY was unhurried, lacked room nearing the quarter pole, checked, responded and finished with good energy. BONGO BOY was well placed five wide on the turn, lodged a bid outside and finished with good energy. RUMBLE KING an early factor, six wide on the turn, angled wide and lacked a closing bid. PRINCEOFPROXIMITY lagged far back and then passed faders. FIRST REACTION six wide on the turn and weakened. CAPTAIN NOAH set the pace along the four path, was hooked and gave way. DON'T DO THAT BABY lagged back and then finished wide. ALFONSO'S LOSS seven wide leaving the backstretch and tired.
