CELTIC CHANT assumed the lead, set the pace in hand, asked into the lane, opened up and then was under pressure for the win. LYNDSEA'S MISS EL was well placed along the two path on the turns, eased out, gained and finished well. LED ADVANTAGE tracked, three path on the turns and finished with interest. ST. PETE BEACH ducked out at the start, gained along the rail on the last turn, checked in upper stretch and then made late bid. WARMHEARTED SANDY three path on the turns and made a late bid. PITCHING PENNIES was well placed along the rail on the turns and weakened. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of ST. PETE BEACH against LED ADVANTAGE for alleged interference in upper stretch, was quickly dismissed.
