NUMEROUS ONE was well placed along the rail, gained along the two path on the last turn, launched a bid inside to challenge in midstretch, took the lead and then outran JUSTFORTHERECORD to the line. JUSTFORTHERECORD was well placed, gained along the four path on the last turn, battled the winner and just missed. N B RAVENS was well placed, four path on the last turn, challenged from between in midstretch, altered to the inside late and weakened. SPYGLASS jostled at the start, lagged back, two path on the last turn and then made a mild bid. PAYING ATTENTION bumped with SPYGLASS at the start, four path on the final turn and then made a late bid. RED CLASSIC JET vied for the lead after a half mile, shook loose on the last turn, was hooked and weakened. AMERICAN SKY jostled at the start, saved ground and tired. THIRDPOWER set the pace, vied after a half mile and gave way. SAMURAI MOON in hand along the four path up the backstretch, asked on the last turn and tired. JESSIE TOWTRUCK saved ground, was outrun. A claim of foul was lodged by the rider of N B RAVENS against the winner for interference at the sixteenths pole, was not allowed.
