Footnotes

DITA was unhurried five wide up the backstretch, angled to the two path on the turn while outside of CATONERAS, swung wide for the drive, asked and rallied from well out in the strip for the win. CATONERAS was unhurried along the rail, gained with the winner on the turn, swung out in the lane for room, responded and rallied to just miss while between foes nearing the line. BEAR DANCE contested the lead off the rail with TERRY TERESA, battled that one in the lane with success but faltered late to miss. TERRY TERESA contested the lead along the three path on the turn, battled to the outside of BEAR DANCE in midstretch, drifted out late while hard ridden and weakened. AWESOMEATTHETRACK was well placed along the two path on the turn, chased the leaders in the lane and faded. SHA SHEAR EGO was well placed along the rail up the backstretch, angled out three wide into the lane and weakened. BRIER lagged back, saved ground on the turn and tired. SILVER WILLOW four path up the backstretch not in any hurry, continued on that route on the bend, swung wide in the lane and tired.
