SOUND OF DRUMS was well placed off the rail, gained inside on the final turn, quickly took the lead from SEEK TO DESTROY and then widened under the whip for the score. RAECINJASIN never far back along the rail, gained inside on the last turn, lodged a bid along the rail and finished well to earn the place. BLUE SANDS tracked along the four path on the first turn, continued along that path up the backstretch, entered the lane four wide in pursuit of the leader and then finished with interest. SNAP CALL rated while off the rail up the backstretch, angled out into the lane, asked and rallied. SEEK TO DESTROY set the pace along the four path on the first turn, took the three path up the backstretch, four wide on the last turn, was quickly collared, chased and weakened. SHAWKLIT POWER was well placed along the three path on the turns and weakened. ONE STAR FREEDOM unhurried along the three path on the first turn, two path on the last turn and tired.
