MY VALENTINA GIRL was hustled early, contested the lead along rail with DANCE COCOA DANCE, matched strides with that one to the furlong marker, responded when asked and drove clear of the latter for the win. DANCE COCOA DANCE contested the lead along the two path up the backstretch with MY VALENTINA GAL, continued outside of that one on the turn, was loosing ground to the latter leaving the eighth pole and then was clearly no match. CAT'S PLAYMATE was unhurried off the rail, took the two path on the turn with almost eight lengths to make-up, angled out into the lane and closed well. KATLYN ANN was well placed along the three path, tracked the leaders along the two path into the lane, angled out some, lodged a bid and hung. ALEJA GRAND lagged back, three path leaving the backstretch, angled wide in the lane and then improved her position. YES I CAN CAN was well placed early, took the two path on the bend, angled out one more path into the lane and tired. JUSTGIVEMEASECOND checked at the start, gained some along the rail on the turn and tired. NO ANGEL six wide up the backstretch, five wide on the turn and then finished wide. PRIVATE SCREENING five wide up the backstretch, four path on the turn and then continued wide to the line.
